About Discover Law & Justice:

Discover Law & Justice is a beginner mock trial program designed to build students' confidence with written and oral advocacy. Participants will spend three days hearing about the law and arguing a legal case. Sessions will be moderated by local attorneys and judges and principals will be coached by Willamette College of Law students. Lunch will be provided daily.

The program will conclude with a final trial on the afternoon of March 30th.

Guests are welcome to come watch the final trial. Oregon Court of Appeals Judge Darleen Ortega will preside over the final trial.
